



Global Overview

Industry Outlook

- India's food processing sector is expected to reach by \$535 Bn by 2025-26
- India's food sector attracted \$ 4.18 Bn in foreign direct investment between April 2014-March 2020
- 90% of the food processing market is untapped, hence huge opportunity in the sector
- Only 25% of the food processing sector is currently organized providing tremendous opportunity for backward and forward integration
- 11.6% of the employment share
- ▶ 10.4% of the country's total exports
- The food processing sector is the 5th largest manufacturing in the country






Food Processing Ecosystem Of Madhya Pradesh





Incentives for Large Scale Food Processing Industries

For Investment more than INR 50 Crores in P&M

- Basic Investment Promotion Assistance (BIPA) Upto 60%
- Incentive on Employment generation Upto 1.5x BIPA
- Benefits to Export Oriented units Upto 1.2x BIPA
- Infrastructure Development Assistance for Power, Water and Road
- Green Industrialization Assistance for ETP, STP, ZLD etc
- Financial assistance for Food Processing Infrastructure Cold Chains & Warehouse
- Rebate in Power Tariff
- Electricity Duty Exemption
- Mandi Fee Reimbursement
- Reimbursement of Patent charges



Incentives for Food Processing MSMEs

- Industrial Development Subsidy up to 40% on plant and machinery
- Upto INR 5 Lakhs for patents/IPR registration
- > Food Park: 15% of project cost (Max. INR 5 Cr.) & Stamp Duty Reimbursement

Additional Incentives for Investment up to INR 10 Cr in P&M


- Additional Subsidy @8% for SC/ST/Women on IPA
- Additional incentives @12% for Exporting Units
- Financial assistance up to Rs 5 Lakhs for quality certifications (Upto Rs 25 Lakhs investment)
- ► Energy audit expenses INR 5 Lakhs
- ▶ Infrastructure Development Assistance (upto Industrial Premises) - up to INR 25 Lacs
- ➤ Setting up ETP- up to INR 25 Lacs

Additional Incentives for Investment INR 10-50 Cr in P&M

- ► Power Tariff Rebate @ INR 1/Unit or 20% whichever is less
- ▶ Mandi Fee Exemption up to 50% of P&M for 5 years
- Infrastructure Development Assistance (upto Industrial premises) up to INR 3 Cr.
- Setting up ETP up to INR 1 Cr.
