

Global Overview

- ► Global textile & apparel market is valued at US\$ 869 Bn in 2021-22, expected to grow at CAGR of 3.5%
- At the current CAGR, forecasted Global Textile & Apparel market to reach US\$ 1000 Bn by 2025-26


Indian Overview

India's textile and garments exports (including handicrafts) stood at US\$ 44.4 billion in FY22, a 41% increase YoY.

India is the 5th largest exporter of Textiles & Apparel and holds 4% share of the global trade in the sector

95% of the world's hand-woven fabric comes from India

Madhya Pradesh, Tamil, Nadu, Gujarat, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh are major textile hubs

Strong global demand from India

India's textile and apparel industry contributed 7% to the industry output (by value).

The Indian textile and apparel industry contributed 2% to the GDP and 12% to export earnings.


India's exports of textiles and apparel are expected to reach \$100 bn in the next 5 years, growing at a CAGR of 11%

India recorded its highest textile exports of US\$ 44.4 billion in FY22, a 41% increase from FY 21"

Trade agreements with Mauritius, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Australia and UAE would open infinite opportunities

Africa and Latin America could be the potential markets for Indian textile in coming decade

Textiles companies have invested in both greenfield and brownfield projects







Major textile export markets of MP



Key facts about Organic Cotton Production in MP




38% of India's Organic Cotton is produced in Madhya Pradesh (Last Four Years)

- Cost of company for manpower is cheaper by 30-35% in MP







- Provision for Power Tariff Rebates and ElectricityDuty Exemptions
